Applicants will be considered based on the following criteria:

- 4 year High School Choir Member (preferably Middle School years too)
- Participated/volunteered at 2 or more Choir Events including but not limited to: Bohemian Supper Club, ISSMA Solo and Ensemble, Vocal Jazz Ensemble, Great American Songbook
- 3.0 GPA
- High Standard of Leadership and Motivation
- Short Essay explaining your contribution to the Choir
- 1 Letter of Recommendation (not from the director/s)

Applications must be complete to qualify. All application materials must be turned in to be considered. Letters of recommendation must be given to student in a sealed envelope or sent separately by recommender.
